May 4th – May 22nd

- Promise Towns is open Monday – Thursday: 8:30AM (drop off) – 4:00PM (pick up)

May 25th – May 29th

- **Promise Town is Closed**
- **No fees are charged for this week**
- Janitors will give the entire building an additional deep clean
- Staff will get much needed break to prepare for summer the transition

June 1st – July 31st

- Promise Towns is open Monday – Friday: 8:30AM (drop off) – 4:00PM (pick up)
- Closed in observance of July 4th holiday, on Friday July 3rd.

I understand that this decision will have a big impact in your daily routine. I, however, liken this current re-opening plan to a physician's prescription. I do not believe we stop taking the medication just because our symptoms have decreased and we are "feeling better", but we must finish the entire prescription as ordered to reap the full benefit of the "medication" prescribed.
